The Company

Mac's Convenience Store has been operated by its current owners for the past three years, and is a privately owned and operated franchise. The convenience store retails food, fast food, tobacco products, dairy products, frostees, lottery tickets and prepaid cell phone cards. The store also has a comprehensive variety of magazines and newspapers.

A 24 hour convenience store, Mac's also has a self-serve gas bar and sells diesel fuel and propane. Customers can also obtain subs, sandwiches, and Seattle Best Coffee.

The Work

The company employs three full-time staff as Cashier/Gas Attendant/Food Attendant. The work requires standing for long periods of time, and may require some lifting of product. Staff may be required to maintain sidewalk, assist gas customers or assist delivery men to unload product.

Hours of Work and Wages

Employees are expected to work one of three eight hour shifts in a 24 hour period: 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m. to midnight or midnight to 8:00 a.m. Wages are negotiable. Overtime is paid. Vacation and vacation pay are in compliance with the *Labour Standards Act*.
