The services offered include a complete range of medical, surgical and dental services, including surgical laser and therapeutic laser treatments. The Clinic also offers grooming and boarding services for dogs and cats.

Currently, the Clinic has 8 full time employees, including a veterinarian, kennel assistants and animal health technologists.

The work requires working in a group environment, handling and caring for domestic pets and farm animals, in a modern, clean facility. The work may require assisting in surgical treatment, grooming, and general care.

- Must hold a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (D.V.M. or V.M.D.) degree from an accredited college of veterinary medicine
- Must have current registration as a veterinarian with the ability to be licensed in Alberta
- Responsible for a mixed practice
- Management experience is an asset

Training

The Clinic provides in house training for all technicians and assistants.

Hours of Work, Pay and Benefits

Hours of work are typically Monday to Friday from 8:15 a.m. to 5:15 p.m., and Saturday from 8:15 a.m. until Noon (winter months). The Clinic is closed on Sundays and Statutory Holidays.

The Veterinarian is on call 24/7.

Salaries are dependent upon qualifications and experience. Vacations are in accordance with the requirements of the *Labour Standards Act* of Alberta. There is a group health and benefit package available for full time employees.
